Exemption from Mining Act 1992 Section 6 (Unauthorised Carrying out of Ancillary Mining Activity) Order 2023

I, TONY LINNANE, Acting Executive Director Assessments and Systems, Mining Exploration and Geoscience within the Department of Regional NSW, with the delegated authority of the Minister, pursuant to clause 11 of the Mining Regulation 2016, exempt the class of persons specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 from the operation of section 6 of the *Mining Act 1992* with respect to the carrying out of the class of ancillary mining activities specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1.

Unless otherwise stated, words and expressions that are defined in the Act or the Regulation have the same meaning in this Order.

This exemption will have effect from 30 November 2023 until 30 November 2024.

Proposed Declaration of Public Lands Available for Hunting Game Animals

I, The Hon TARA MORIARTY, M.L.C, Minister for Agriculture, pursuant to section 20(3) of the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002* and in accordance with clause 23 of the Game and Feral Animal Control Regulation 2022 give public notice of a proposed declaration under section 20 of the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002*. NOTE:

- a) Section 5(1) of the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002* defines a game animal as any animal specified in schedule 3 to that Act that is living in the wild
- b) Section 18 of the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002* requires a person to hold a restricted game hunting licence to hunt game animals on declared public land (there are limited exemptions to this requirement in s17).
- c) A person who hunts game on the declared land must gain written permission from Forestry Corporation of NSW or the Regulatory Authority prior to accessing the declared land.
- d) Section 20(10) of the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act* 2002 makes clear that a declaration under s20 does not confer authority for anything that is inconsistent with the requirements of any other Act or law.
