A fireworks display will be conducted over the navigable waters of Lemon Tree Passage at the location specified above. Fireworks will be launched from a moored firing barge at the above location. The area directly around this firing position may be dangerous and hazardous to other waterway users while fireworks are being launched.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, extending 150 metres around the moored barge. This zone will be indicated by the presence of control vessels which will be stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Swimming legs of a triathlon event will be conducted on the waters of Jervis Bay at the location specified above.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Murray River – entire width of the river, between the Torrumbarry Weir (at the 1630km river marker) and 1 kilometre upstream from Wills Bend (at the 1682km river marker), near the township of Echuca.

Duration

6.00am to 6.00pm – Saturday 9 December 2023

Detail

Competitive water ski racing will be conducted on the waters of the Murray River, at the location specified above. The event will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow-lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the full width of the Murray River as detailed above. The Zone will be marked at each end by the presence of Maritime and control vessels. There will also be support vessels present to manage the event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

ELECTRIC SCOOTER USE AREA EXEMPTION NOTICE 2023

1 Name of Notice

This Notice is the *Electric Scooter Use Area Exemption (Albury City Council) Notice 2023.*

2 Commencement

This Notice has effect on and from the 8 December 2023.

3 Effect

This Notice remains in force up to and including the repeal of Part 15-1 of the Road Rules 2014 unless revoked or amended earlier.

4 Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Notice have the same meaning as in the Road Rules 2014 unless otherwise stated.

5 Exemption of the operation of road rule 262-1

Riders of electric scooters are exempt from road rule 262-1 on roads within the Albury City Council local government area as indicated by the area labelled 'Operational Area' provided at Schedule One to this Notice.

6 Publication

This Notice is to be published in the NSW Government Gazette.


Explanatory note:

Road rule 262-1 prohibits the riding of electric scooters on a road unless those riders are exempt by a Notice made by Transport for NSW under road rule 262-2 which specifies an area included in the Notice.

Only persons 16 years and over may legally ride an electric scooter borrowed or hired under a share scheme and are also subject to other road transport laws including specific road rules for electric scooter riders at Part 15-1 of the Road Rules 2014 (including riding an electric on a road on which the ordinary speed limit is greater than 50 kilometres per hour).
