## VEXATIOUS PROCEEDINGS ACT 2008

### Notification of Orders Concerning Vexatious Litigant

Gurjit Singh

On 26th April 2024, his Honour Justice Ierace made the following Orders in matter **2023/00171969 Attorney General for NSW v Gurjit Singh** under the Vexatious Proceedings Act 2008 (NSW):

- (1) Pursuant to s 8(7)(b) of the Vexatious Proceedings Act 2008 (NSW) Gurjit Singh is prohibited from instituting proceedings in New South Wales other than with leave of an appropriate court under that Act.
- (2) No order is made as to costs.
