VEXATIOUS PROCEEDINGS ACT 2008

Notification of Orders Concerning Vexatious Litigant

Gurjit Singh

On 26th April 2024, his Honour Justice lerace made the following Orders in matter **2023/00171969 Attorney General for NSW v Gurjit Singh** under the Vexatious Proceedings Act 2008 (NSW):

(1) Pursuant to s 8(7)(b) of the Vexatious Proceedings Act 2008 (NSW) Gurjit Singh is prohibited from instituting proceedings in New South Wales other than with leave of an appropriate court under that Act.

(2) No order is made as to costs.
