## NOTICE OF RESERVATION OF A NATIONAL PARK

I, the Honourable Andrew Scott Bell, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of Section 71BC of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*, reserve the land described in the Schedule below as part of **Gulaga National Park** and as part of the area leased from Merrimans Local Aboriginal Land Council and Wagonga Local Aboriginal Land Council under Part 4A of that Act.
