The Draft Dealing in Protected Birds Code of Practice is available for community feedback

The Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water is seeking feedback from the public on the Draft Dealing in Protected Birds Code of Practice 2023. Under the proposed Code of Practice, Code Regulated bird species will no longer require a Biodiversity Conservation Licence for the purposes of private animal keeping.
