LIQUOR ACT 2007

Declaration of special event extended trading for events of regional, State or national significance

I, David Harris MP, Minister for Gaming and Racing, pursuant to section 13 of the *Liquor Act 2007*, repeal my declaration dated 7 February 2024, and in its place, **DO HEREBY DECLARE** an extended trading period for special events of regional, State or National significance, as set out in Schedule 1 below.

This declaration takes effect on the date this notice is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

Guidance notes

- 'Relevant venues' includes Hotels, General Bars, Clubs, Small Bars and Dedicated Live Music & Performance Venues.
- **Midnight**, in relation to a particular day, means the point of time at which that day ends.
