1 Name of Notice

This Notice is the ***Electric Scooter Use Area Exemption (Albury City Council) Notice 2024***.

2 Commencement and effect

This Notice has effect on and from the 14 June 2024 and remains in force up to and including the repeal of Part 15-1 of the Road Rules 2014 unless revoked or amended earlier.

3 Revocation

The Notice titled ***Electric Scooter Use Area Exemption (Albury City Council) Notice 2023*** published in the NSW Government Gazette No.569 on 8 December 2023 at pages 10 – 11, is revoked.

4 Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Notice have the same meaning as in the Road Rules 2014 unless otherwise stated.

5 Exemption of the operation of road rule 262-1

Riders of electric scooters are exempt from road rule 262-1 on roads within the Albury City Council local government area as indicated by the area labelled 'Operational Area' provided at Schedule One to this Notice.

6 Publication

This Notice is to be published in the NSW Government Gazette.

Explanatory note:

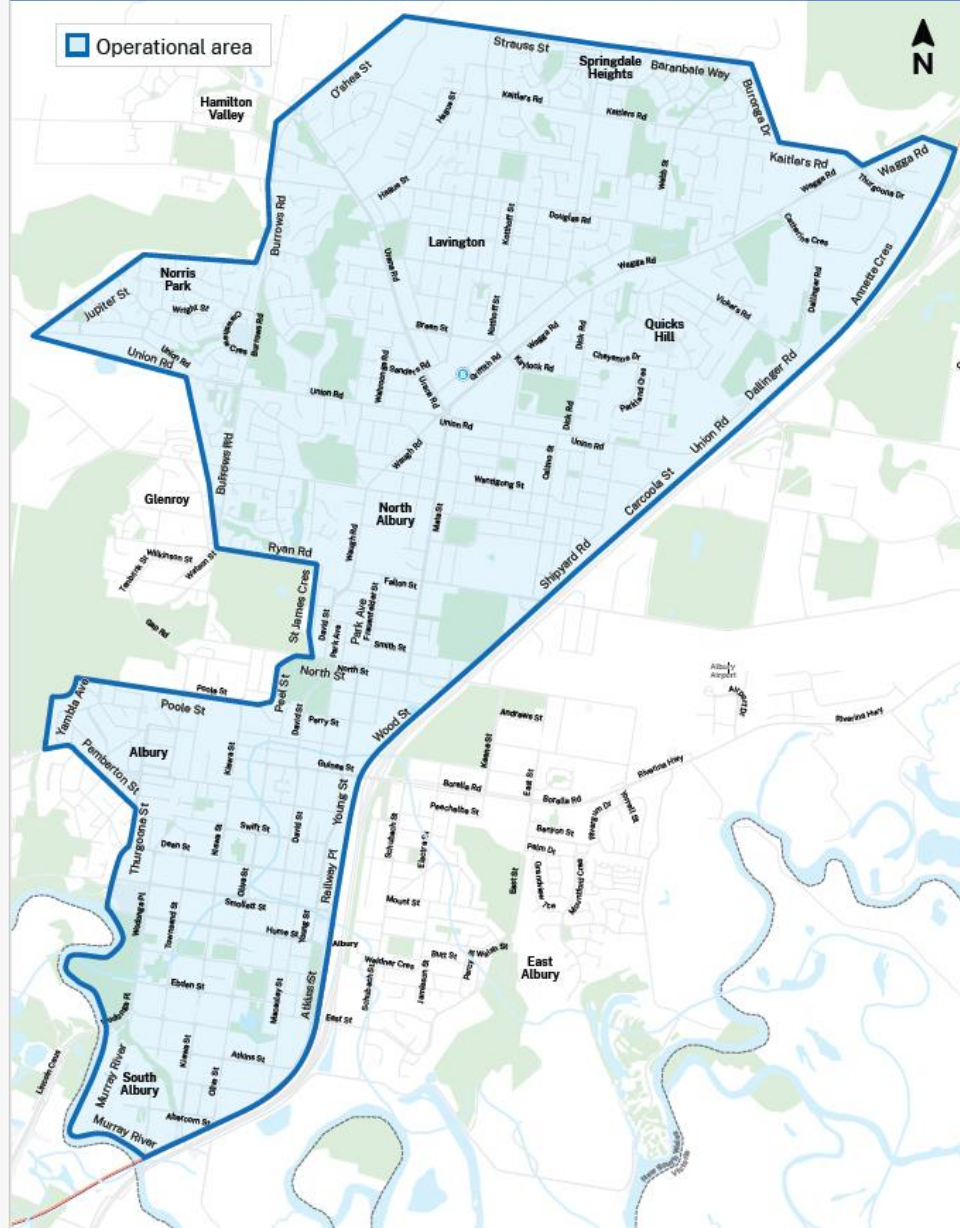
Road rule 262-1 prohibits the riding of electric scooters on a road unless those riders are exempt by a Notice made by Transport for NSW under road rule 262-2 which specifies an area included in the Notice.

Only persons 16 years and over may legally ride an electric scooter borrowed or hired under a share scheme and are also subject to other road transport laws including specific road rules for electric scooter riders at Part 15-1 of the Road Rules 2014 (including riding an electric on a road on which the ordinary speed limit is greater than 50 kilometers per hour)

- (a) who is entitled to hold any of the following cards issued by the Commonwealth:

 - (ii) a card known as a gold repatriation health card that is embossed with TPI, EDA, WAR WIDOW or WAR WIDOWER,
Note. TPI refers to totally and permanently incapacitated and EDA refers to extreme disablement adjustment.
 - (iii) a card prescribed by the regulations as being equivalent to any of those cards, or
- (b) who is entitled to receive, in respect of any injury or disease, a pension, or other amount, approved by Transport for NSW that is payable under the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* of the Commonwealth or the *Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004* of the Commonwealth, or
- (c) who is a war widow or war widower (within the meaning of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* of the Commonwealth), or
- (d) who is under 16 years of age and named as a dependant on the current New South Wales Pensioner Concession Card in (a) above, or
- (e) who is under 16 years of age and holds a current New South Wales Centrelink Health Care Card.
