

ROAD RULES 2014

Approved Bicycle Helmet

Transport for NSW approves the following helmets for the purposes of the definition of an *approved bicycle helmet* in the Dictionary to the Road Rules 2014:

- a) an *approved bicycle helmet* means a helmet made in compliance with:
 - i. Australian/New Zealand Standard AS/NZS 2063:2008 *Bicycle helmets*; or
 - ii. Australian/New Zealand Standard AS/NZS 2063:2020, *Helmets for use on bicycles and wheeled recreational devices*; or
 - iii. European Standard EN 1078:2012+A1:2012, *Helmets for pedal cyclists and for users of skateboards and roller skates*; or
 - iv. Snell B-95, 1995 Bicycle Helmet Standard, 1998 revision *Standard for Protective Headgear for Use in Bicycling*; or
 - v. American Society for Testing and Materials Standard ASTM F1447:2018, *Standard Specification for Helmets Used in Recreational Bicycling or Roller Skating*; or
 - vi. Consumer Product Safety Commission (16 C.F.R. Part 1203), *Safety Standard for Bicycle Helmets*, and
- b) that has an identifying mark certifying compliance with a standard mentioned in paragraph (a), and
- c) that is in good repair and proper working order and condition.
