ORDER

Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008*, the Order that took effect on and from 6 July 2018, on Dr Joseph Anthony Grech **(MED0001045060)** of LEICHHARDT NSW 2040, prohibiting him as a medical practitioner, from supplying, having possession of or issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101 and 77 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 15 November 2023.
