REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Lake Illawarra – extending from the shoreline of Burroo Point near the land-based locality of Skiway Park at Oak Flats.

Duration

6:30am to 4:30pm – Saturday 2 March 2024

Detail

Dragon boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Illawarra at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, comprising of a square shape (approximately 250 metres by 250 metres), which will be indicated by the presence of buoys and control vessels stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – Marine Safety Act 1998).

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga.

Duration

8:00am to 6:00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 2 March 2024
- Sunday 3 March 2024

Detail

Water ski races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga as specified above. This will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel use between the above times for this event. The Zone will be monitored by event staff and control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – Marine Safety Act 1998).

Detail

Competitive power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters as specified above, involving the use of high-speed power vessels presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events, and will be marked by buoys and indicated by control vessels stationed on the perimeter.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – Marine Safety Act 1998).
