Dragon boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Clarence River, Grafton as specified above.

- a course from Memorial Park to approximately 2km upstream on the northern side of Susan Island on Saturday 9 March 2024, and
- a 200-metre course adjacent to Memorial Park only on Sunday 10 March 2024.

- 2.00pm to 7.00pm on Saturday 9 March 2024 the Murray River between the 1122km river marker (1km downstream of the Robinvale-Euston Road Bridge) and the 1140km river marker (2km upstream of the Bumbang Cutting).
- 7.00am to 7.00pm on Sunday 10 March 2024 the Murray River between the 1122km river marker (1km downstream of the Robinvale-Euston Road Bridge) and the 1164km river marker (junction of the Murray River and Bonvaricall Creek).

Duration

7.00am to 7.00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 9 March 2024
- Sunday 10 March 2024

Detail

Competitive ski racing will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Murray River as specified above.

The event will involve the use of high-speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow-lines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the full width of the Murray River between the locations detailed on the respective days above. The area will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times specified above.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) – Marine Safety Act 1998).
