ORDER

Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* the Order that took effect on and from 12 November 2021, issued to **Mr Mazen Zoghbi (PHA0001048645)** of Wallsend NSW 2287, prohibiting him as a pharmacist from supplying or having possession of, or manufacturing any preparation, admixture or extract of a drug of addiction as authorised by clauses 101(1) and 102 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 11 March 2024.

ORDER

Restoration of Drug Authority

In accordance with the provisions of clause 175(1) of the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008*, the Order that took effect on and from 9 November 2022, on **Dr Simon Chun-Chi Kam (MED0000939659)** of Umina Beach NSW 2257, prohibiting him as a medical practitioner from supplying or having possession of drugs of addiction as authorised by clause 101 of the Regulation, and issuing a prescription for a drug of addiction as authorised by clause 77 of the Regulation, shall cease to operate on and from 11 March 2024.
